Dear Secretary Kander:

This opinion letter responds to your request dated January 21, 2016, for our review under § 116.334, RSMo, of a proposed summary statement prepared for the petition submitted by Andrew Linhares regarding a proposed amendment to amend Chapter 386, Revised Statutes of Missouri, version 8 (2016-188). The proposed summary statement is as follows:

Shall Missouri law be amended to:

- require retail electric suppliers to make net metering available to more customers and to offer the interconnection and metering arrangements and community renewable energy credits necessary to facilitate and support community renewable access arrangements; and
- establish a tax credit, through June 2031, for costs and expenses for the construction, design and installation of solar powered electric energy generation units that meet the

requirements for net metering or are a part of
a community renewable access arrangement?

Pursuant to § 116.334, RSMo, we approve the legal content and form of the proposed statement. Because our review of the statement is mandated by statute, no action that we take with respect to such review should be construed as an endorsement of the petition, nor as the expression of any view regarding the objectives of its proponents.
