Dear Secretary Kander:

This opinion letter responds to your request dated March 3, 2016, for our review under § 116.334, RSMo, of a proposed summary statement prepared for the petition submitted by David Klindt regarding a proposed amendment to amend Chapter 386, Revised Statutes of Missouri (2016-219). The proposed summary statement is as follows:

Shall Missouri law be amended to:

- allow owners or operators of qualified electric energy generation units to generate up to, but not exceeding, 100 percent of their electrical energy requirements;
- not require both rural electric cooperatives or municipal utilities that have fewer than 10,000 connected meters to be retail electric suppliers that offer net metering; and
- allow retail electric suppliers to charge net metering customers a fee or charge for providing the service, if such fee or charge is

approved by the Public Service Commission or
the local governing body of the retail electric
supplier?

Pursuant to § 116.334, RSMo, we approve the legal content and form of
the proposed statement. Because our review of the statement is mandated by
statute, no action that we take with respect to such review should be
construed as an endorsement of the petition, nor as the expression of any
view regarding the objectives of its proponents.
